#### **City of Waltham**

Consolidated Public Works Department Contract for Snow Plowing Equipment 2013-2014 Season

#### I. OVERVIEW OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The City of Waltham (hereafter City) intends this contract to be for the plowing and removal of snow by Contractor(s) to provide labor and equipment to provide and perform such snow plowing to **be paid for on an hourly basis**, both for normal snow plowing and snow removal. To facilitate such snow removal efforts, the CPW Department has established snow plowing routes and has evaluated the number and type of equipment needed by each route. CPW will assign such vehicles and equipment to a specific section and route during all normal plowing operations at the City's discretion for any and all contractor(s) entering into this Agreement and Contract. The City reserves the right to assign and has the sole and absolute discretion to assign or reassign the Contractor and his/her vehicles and equipment to specified routes as mentioned above.

The rates for snow plowing equipment are established herein and are attached hereto as Rider 1. Normal plowing operations will be defined generally to be snowfalls in excess of or anticipated to be in excess of 2". In snowfall of less than 2", the City intends to utilize its own equipment, unless there are extenuating circumstances or the City chooses otherwise in its discretion. The City CPW Department (hereafter CPW) reserves the right to call Contractors and their vehicles and equipment on an as needed basis, due to some snowfalls being heavier or falling earlier or other situations as determined by the City.

The City reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to determine and be the final arbiter of whether the Contractor is or has been in total compliance with any and all the terms, conditions and intent of this Agreement and Contract (hereafter, Contract).

Contractor shall be prohibited from assigning any of it rights or responsibilities under this Contract and shall also be prohibited from subcontracting, reassigning, sharing or otherwise altering the routes or streets and equipment assigned to the Contractor, unless the Contractor has given the City prior written request and identification of such, including the proposed subcontractor and its vehicles and equipment and the City's CPW Director has approved such request in writing.

It is the intent of the City of Waltham (hereafter, City) under this Contract, in which the Contractor agrees, that the City shall only be responsible to pay for and only pay the Contractor for the time Contractor spends in actually working in plowing and removing snow (in all its forms including slush, sleet, mixed ice and snow, etc.) from City property and streets and ways in the City as assigned to Contractor by the City hereunder. Thus, for example, the City shall not be billed for and shall not pay for any time that Contractor is not actually plowing and removing snow from its assigned route(s) with its designated plowing and snow removal vehicle(s) and equipment – such situations disqualifying Contractor from payment include but are not limited to:

- a.) being on an unassigned route/street;
- b.) driving on the assigned route/street without plowing/pushing or removing snow (including having the plow or snow removal blade or implement not in contact with the roadway surface);
- c.) re-plowing bare or almost bare pavement;
- d.) plowing or removing snow at too slow a rate given the conditions.

#### II. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- A) Equipment contracted for must be available at all times, seven days a week, including holidays and must be capable of responding within one hour of notification.
- B) Upon execution of this contract, each piece of equipment contracted for normal plowing operations will be assigned by the CPW Department to a particular route. Streets on all routes are to be plowed in the sequence designated by the CPW Department. It shall be the contractor's responsibility to become familiar and to familiarize any of Contractor's vehicle operators with all the routes assigned. Maps of each Route and Section are included in Appendix A and Supervisory personnel of the CPW Department will be available to assist in the familiarization and to advise the contractor of any special conditions which may generally be encountered, on the route. This familiarization process, shall be initiated, if needed, by Contractor's request and shall be done before November 15th or prior to the first snow storm, whichever is earlier. The Contractor's failure to fully comply with this provision shall be the basis for immediate termination of this Contract with Contractor, in the sole discretion of the City and its CPW Department.
- C) The contractor shall be responsible for all fuels, ballasts, repairs, materials, and/or equipment necessary to perform fully and completely, as determined in City's discretion hereunder. Further, it shall be the contractor's responsibility to assure equipment availability at all times during plowing operations. The City reserves the right to terminate a contract at any time for failure of equipment availability or other breach of Contractor's duties and performance under this contract.
- D) Equipment called in must arrive at its designated check-in point within one (1) hour of being called, and must be ready to begin plowing operations upon arrival.

- E) Rental time will begin from the time of check in and end at the time of check out. The CPW may modify the reporting time based on GPS.
- F) The above snow plowing and removal operations shall be performed to produce as close to bare pavement as possible and all streets shall be widened to maximum width (curb-to-curb). All intersections shall be cleaned to their full widths. A plowing operation shall not be deemed complete until it has met the above standards to the approval of the City and the CPW Department.
- G) All plowing operations shall be continuous and shall continue without interruption unless said interruption is authorized by the CPW Director.
- H) In a normal snow plowing operation, work shall be completed to the standards described herein within a reasonable time as determined by the CPW Director.
- I) In the event that a contractor is providing multiple vehicles, the contractor must provide to the City of Waltham CPW a contact person who will act for the contractor as a field coordinator. This contact person must be able to reach all vehicles under his responsibility and must also be available for plowing as needed. The name of the Contact person and his/her cell phone number shall be provided to the CPW in writing. Throughout the Contract if any changes to the Contact person or cell numbers occur they shall be submitted in writing to CPW.
- J) All Contractors must carry a cell phone for easy contact with the CPW. Contractors hereby agree to GPS tracking as outlined in the attached GPS Agreement Rider which shall be signed by the contractor as part of this Agreement. Any abuse of the GPS system will result in immediate termination of the Contractor by the City and without recourse to the Contractor.
- K) As outlined above the City and its CPW Department has sole and exclusive discretion to determine whether Contractor has been in compliance with any and all terms of this Contract.
- L.) All contractors must have current plates, registration, and insurance on all vehicles and proper inspection stickers issued by and/or required by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and provide proof of the same prior to commencing work for the City. The City reserves the right to require Contractors to produce the same during any period of the contract.
- M.) Prior to a snow event the Contractor shall notify **CPW 311 Call Center at 781-314-3855** if any equipment is out of service. Equipment must be returned to service as soon as possible. The Contractor must make alternate plans to have snow removed from a route until the Equipment is returned to service. The City may make alternate plans to have snow removed from a route until the Contractor notifies the CPW 311 Center (781-314-3855) that the equipment is back in service.

#### III. ADMINISTRATION OF SNOW PLOWING AND REMOVAL

- A) An agent of the CPW Director, City Snow Inspector, shall be assigned to oversee the performance compliance of Contractor's contracted equipment. Each Snow Inspector shall be responsible for a designated group of routes. Planning operations shall be conducted in accordance with the direction of said Snow Inspector and with the standards described herein. In no instance shall a plowing operation be deemed complete until it has been approved by said Snow Inspector.
- B) Equipment must check in and check out from the Waltham City Yard, located at 167 Lexington St. in Waltham, or at the designated meeting point. Equipment must arrive fully fueled, plows and equipment in good working condition, prepared to plow, loaded with appropriate ballast and having chains available for use if needed (as determined by the CPW Director).
- C.) In the event that a Contractor's equipment fails during a plowing operation, the Contractor, or his representative, must notify the City Snow Inspector for that route immediately and have the route covered with other equipment. If the City Snow Inspector cannot be reached the Contractor shall notify the CPW 311 Center (781-314-3855). Equipment must be returned to service as soon as possible. The Contractor must notify the City Snow Inspector or the CPW 311 Center (781-314-3855) when the failed equipment is back in service.
- D) Each piece of contracted equipment will be provided with a permanent identification tag affixed to the truck body on both sides, provided by the CPW Department. The identification shall be affixed permanently to the vehicle identifying it as a City of Waltham Snow Plow.

#### IV. EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS

- A) The Contractor accepts full responsibility to schedule vehicle inspections at the City Yard located at 167 Lexington Street or at a location to be determined by the CPW Director. Inspections will occur over several weeks designated by the City. Tentative plans are for this to occur between October 15 and December 1.
- B) All paperwork related to vehicle inspections shall be sent to the Director of Consolidated Public Works at Consolidated Public Works, 165 Lexington Street, Waltham, MA 02452. The Director of Consolidated Public Works will subsequently contact responsive and responsible bidders to schedule the inspections. The Contractor must schedule the inspections through the Director of Consolidated Public Works either in writing or by calling (781) 314-3800. The inspections will take place Monday through Friday at the discretion of the Director of Consolidated Public

Works. The Director of Consolidated Public Works may make one or two Saturdays available for inspections. Failure to schedule an inspection shall be deemed to be solely the fault of the Contractor. The City will not assume any responsibility or liability for failure of the Contractor to have the vehicles inspected.

- C) The Vehicle at the time of inspection must fully meet all conditions set forth in this contract. All equipment must be inspected by CPW prior to acceptance. The Contractors plow must also pass inspection. If the equipment does not pass inspection the first time, the contractor may modify the equipment and request a reinspection or supply another piece of equipment after submitting the necessary documentation. However, in no event will a contractor be given a third opportunity to pass an inspection if either the original or the replacement equipment fails the second inspection.
- D) The equipment furnished under this contract must be in accordance with the following specifications and fully comply with any and all applicable motor vehicle laws, including but not limited to the laws of the State of Massachusetts, and this also includes providing copies of a valid Massachusetts State Registration and valid inspection sticker, and also be fully insured and carrying liability insurance limits of at least \$300,000 per person and \$1,000,000 per incident.
- E) All equipment must be in excellent condition, operating smoothly, clean inside and out and under the hood, with evidence of proper maintenance and inspection.
- F) The City of Waltham reserves the right to reject any piece of equipment that does not comply fully with this specification at any time during the term of the contract.
- G) The contract price shall include, without limitation, all costs involved in furnishing the operator, insurance, repairs, ballast, chains, fuel, oil, lubricants and all other costs related to the operation of the equipment, for optional performance and completion of Contractor's duties under this Agreement.
- H) All electrical and mechanical systems are to be in excellent operating condition. A rotary type light with a yellow/amber lens visible for 360 degrees for each vehicle. and audible warning device in the rear for when vehicle is in reverse.
- I) All vehicles hired by the City of Waltham for "Snow Plowing and Removal" shall be equipped with a proper sized snow plow in good working condition and an even cutting edge.
- J.) Contractor must own any and all vehicles and equipment used by Contractor for performance hereunder (except where there was prior written request and approval for a subcontractor(s) as outlined herein).
- K.) Six-wheel trucks for plowing should be size equivalent to 4-6 yard dump bodies. Smaller trucks and pick-up trucks are for dead end streets and small alleys only.

#### V. PLOWING REQUIREMENTS

The following is a summary or outline of the general standards applicable in providing Contractor's performance hereunder:

- A) Plow all streets within the Route from the center and to the curb or edge of pavement
- B) At the intersections, snow must be plowed parallel to the curb so that no snow remains in the intersection. Intersections must be curved and snow deposited on tangent sections of street beyond radius.
- C) Do not turn around in private driveways nor deposit any plowed or removed snow material on private property or so as to "block-in" private driveways.
- D) Plow at a speed which is sufficient to move the snow, but not excessive.
- E) Plow with loose hoisting chain so plow rides on casters.
- F) Plow all streets the full width of the pavement (curb-to-curb).
- G) Assigned School Department parking lots should be plowed simultaneously with the street plowing operations when feasible.
- H) One-way streets shall be plowed to each curb. That is, the operator shall plow the left side of the centerline of the street to the left side and plow the right side of the centerline of the street to the right side. At no time shall the contractors operator plow a one-way street the wrong way against the traffic pattern without the express permission of the Director of Consolidated Public Works.

Again, as outlined above, and applicable to all terms and provisions of this Contract and its interpretation, the City shall have sole and exclusive discretion to determine the Contractor's compliance with all terms under this contract and the city shall be the sole and final arbiter, in such discretion, of such compliance and performance.

#### VI. General Conditions

- A) The work day runs from 12:01 a.m., to 12:00 midnight, for as long as the City requires Contractor's services for snow plowing and removal.
- B) Rental time will be figured from the time checked in with the City. Payment due for hours worked will be computed to the nearest half hour, as determined in the City's discretion. The CPW may modify the reporting time based on GPS.

- C) As outlined above, no time will be accrued and no payment shall be made for any time a vehicle or piece of equipment is not performing its assigned task, regardless of reason.
- D) Certificates of insurance for all vehicles and equipment must be submitted whenever requested by the City covering the anticipated period of and dates for performance under this contract.
- E) No payments shall be made until approved contracts and all other documentation requested are on file with the CPW and Contractor has produced all requested documentation, performance, or other materials. Required documentation can be found in Appendix B.
- F) It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to see that all vehicle operators, as well as all vehicles and equipment, are and remain properly licensed under existing laws and regulations. A copy of all operators licenses shall be provided to the City and the City of Waltham CPW will hold said licenses in a secure area, in the Directors office. Contractor shall immediately remove from its work force that is operating vehicles within the City, any operator whose licensing is suspended, terminated or whose licensing is under review for potential suspension.
- G) It is the responsibility of the contractor to keep the insurance and registration of all vehicles and equipment current during the life span of the contract. Registration changes shall be reported as soon as possible to the CPW Department.
- H) All trucks and equipment listed must be made available at all times for plowing unless specifically stated otherwise. The contractor shall identify, by vehicle identification number and registration, all equipment to be used for plowing routes assigned by the City.
- I) U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) regulations regarding drug and alcohol abuse in the workplace shall be complied with.
- J) The contractor shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City of Waltham, its agents and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses, including attorney's fees, arising out of or resulting from the performance or work called for under this contract, or breach thereof. Contractor's shall also be responsible for any and all costs, expenses and liabilities for any claim, damage, loss or expense, arising out of Contractor's actions, neglect or breach, including but not limited to any that:
  - (1) is attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, or to any injury to or destruction of tangible property including the loss of use resulting therefrom, and
  - (2) is caused in whole or in part by any act or omission of the contractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by the contractor, or anyone for whose acts the

- contractor may be liable, regardless of whether or not it caused in part by the party indemnified hereunder.
- (3) Contractor's liabilities shall also include, damages to personal properties, such as, but not limited to, fences, walls, curbing, driveway aprons, irrigation systems and lawn damage and mail boxes. A quick response is expected for repairs.
- K) Certificates of insurance for vehicle liability coverage must be submitted showing coverage for the contract period. (all vehicles must be listed on the insurance certificate.) The Certificate of Insurance needs to have written, endorsed by amendment, in the Description of Services the following <a href="PRECISE">PRECISE</a> language: "The City of Waltham is a named additional insured for General Liability and Automobile"
- L) Contractors will be required to sign a certification form when submitting invoices to Receive payment from the City of Waltham, stating that "Under penalties of perjury that all statements set forth are true, to the best of my knowledge"
- M) Retainage in the amount of ten percent (10%) will be held back from each amount approved for payment. All retainage will be paid by June 15 each year, provided that all contract requirements have been satisfied including but not limited to; GPS compliance, property damage, and condition assessment of snowplowing operations.

- 2. Contractor shall at all times when assigned snow and ice removal operations log-in, shall have the Sprint Handset turned on, in working condition, have the unit properly placed to send and received a proper signal, and maintain the GPS equipment in all vehicles used for the operation of snow and ice control. GPS handsets are not interchangeable and are not assignable by the Contractor to anyone other than the specific vehicle to who it is issued for each storm. Any misuse of the GPS system including, but not limited to, placing one or more GPS systems in the same vehicle/and or placing or permitting a GPS system in a stationary location on a snow route will result in immediate termination of the Contractor without recourse to the Contractor and referral to the appropriate authorities. The City reserves the right to have the Contractor permanently affix the GPS handset or other device to the vehicle plowing for the City.
- 3. The Contractor hereby acknowledges his understanding that failure to follow the said terms and conditions for said GPS equipment may result in the forfeiture of unpaid invoices. Forfeiture of payment will only apply to vehicles engaging in unauthorized activities or failing to comply with GPS procedures. Forfeiture of payment will only apply to the specific vehicles(s) that are in violation of the agreement, and only for the time the violation occurred. This does not apply to GPS equipment failures. All GPS equipment failures must be reported to a City of Waltham Consolidated Public Works Supervisor immediately.
- 4. Contractor shall maintain and operate the GPS equipment in accordance with the handbook supplied by the manufacturer.
- 5. Contractor is required to provide DC/Cigarette Lighter adaptors (positive ground truck) for purposes of charging GPS equipment using the vehicle charging system during hours of operations.
- 6. Contractor shall be responsible for the proper care of all issued GPS equipment including batteries and charging units. The City of Waltham shall be responsible for

the replacement of said GPS equipment, provided the broken or malfunctioning equipment is returned to the City of Waltham promptly. The payment of said replacement equipment by the City of Waltham shall only occur for the first GPS phoned issued (for each vehicle), and shall only occur provided that the GPS equipment was not maliciously and purposely damaged by the Contractor. If the replacement GPS equipment provided by the City of Waltham is damaged, the Contractor shall be responsible for any and all costs for the repair and replacement of the second GPS phone issued for each vehicle and subsequently issued GPS equipment.

7. Contractor shall return GPS equipment to the appropriate City of Waltham Consolidated Public Works director facility upon completion of the work for the winter season of 2013/2014 and each subsequent year of the contract. Any outstanding payments shall not be released prior to the return of non-working GPS phones (for each vehicle), which has not been maliciously or purposely damaged by the Contractor.
