1. PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 1.1 Bids shall be submitted on the "Bid Forms" contained herein.
- 1.2 All entries on the Bid Forms shall be made by typewriter or in ink.
- 1.3 Where so indicated on the Bid Form, sums shall be expressed in both words and figures. Where there is a discrepancy between the bid sum expressed in words and the bid sum expressed in figures, the words shall control.
- 1.4 Any bid received after the time and date specified will not be considered. The bid shall be enclosed in an opaque sealed envelope with the following plainly marked on the outside:

- 1.6 Timely delivery of a bid at the location designated shall be the full responsibility of the Bidder. In the event that City Hall is closed on the date or at the time that bids are due, the date and time for receipt of bids shall be on the next business day that City Hall is open.
- 1.7 Every bid shall be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a bid bond, cash or a certified check, or a treasurer's or cashier's check issued by a responsible bank or trust company, payable to the City of Waltham, MA. The amount of such bid deposit shall be 5% of the total bid.
- 1.8 Each bidder must sign and submit with its Bid, forms certifying that they are in compliance with all requirements of MGL c. 268A (Conduct of Public Officials and Employees) at time the awarding of contract.

1.9 The City reserves the right to vary quantities, to reject any/or all Bids, or any part of any Bid if it deems in its sole discretion to be in the public interest to do so. The City will reject any and all bids in accordance with the above referenced General Laws. In addition, the City reserves the right to waive minor informalities in any or all bids, or to reject any or all bids (in whole or in part) if it be in the public interest to do so.

2. PROVISIONS OF LAW

2.1 All proposals submitted shall be subject to all applicable provisions of law, including specifically but without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Chapter 30B, as amended, of the General Laws.

3. EXAMINATION OF DOCUMENTS AND SITE

- 3.1 Before submitting his proposal, each Bidder shall carefully examine the bid documents, visit the site and thoroughly familiarize himself with the existing conditions relating to construction and labor. Failure to do so will not relieve the bidder from any obligation under his bid as submitted. By submitting a bid, the Bidder agrees and assures that the site, the plans, and the specifications have been examined; that the plans and specification are adequate; and that the required results can be produced under those plans and specifications.

4. INTERPRETATION AND ADDENDA

- 4.1 All questions as to the interpretation of the bid documents, including but not limited to the plans and specifications shall be submitted in writing via email to the CTE LARGE Equipment Consultant, AET Labs at mlyons@aetlabs.com; referencing the Waltham High School Equipment Bid.
- 4.2 The Owner's Project Manager will answer any such questions requiring interpretation of the bid documents, if received not later than 5:00 PM, 1/05 2024 by issuing addenda to the specifications. Such addenda will become part of the Contract Documents. Neither the City of Waltham nor the Equipment Consultant will be responsible for any oral communication.
- 4.3 Any Addenda forming a part of the plans and specifications, or issued before the opening of bids, shall be covered in the bid and shall be a part of the Contract.

5. REQUIREMENTS FOR "FOREIGN CORPORATIONS"

5.1 By submitting a bid, the Bidder agrees if it is a foreign corporation and its bid is accepted, to comply with the requirements of Sections 3 and 5 of Chapter 181 of the Massachusetts General Laws, before the time for execution of the Contract occurs. The term "foreign corporation" means a corporation not incorporated under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

6. GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK

6.1 All items in the plans and specifications shall be furnished and installed, set in place upon delivery as directed by the City of Waltham or its representative or as indicated on drawings, bolted or otherwise fastened if required, and, after connection of services by the building General Contractor, made fully and perfectly operative.

7. EXPLANATION OF REQUIREMENTS IN TECHNICAL SECTIONS

- 7.1 Bidders shall refer to the number coded items in the Technical Specifications, designed to provide each Bidder with a clear understanding of the requirements he must meet. These serve to establish specifically the standard of quality, function and performance of the items to be furnished, and do this by referring to representative manufacturers and detailed specifications. These shall be used as a basis of design in the evaluation of any proposed alternates, see paragraph 12. SAMPLES.
- 7.2 The intent of the Bid Documents is to secure a range of furnishings, necessarily obtained from different suppliers and composed of the work of many different manufacturers, which harmonize not only in function and dimension, but also in appearance. The prime method for obtaining this harmony is through the use of color and finishes. Therefore, as part of the general design, all items, whether named or bid as alternatives, must comply with the overall requirement of color harmony. All color and finish within any single technical section may be required to match exactly. Color and finish on items to be located in adjacent spaces or within the same space may be required to match exactly, if so indicated in their respective color and finish description. In general, the CTE Large Equipment Consultant will require reasonable compliance by all bidders to the stated colors and in so doing will not necessarily be bound by any so-called "standard" or "special" color lists in satisfaction of this requirement. Any bidder seeking to furnish an item not embodying the exact color or finish specified in the Documents must submit their proposed color range to the Equipment Consultant for approval under paragraph 12, SAMPLES. Any item for which colors have not been so submitted and approved will be assumed by the Equipment Consultant to be supplied in the specified colors and finishes.
- 7.3 Special Requirements or product modifications may appear in any technical section for which specific requirements or added information is required; when present in such a section, the Bidder will be held to conformance therein.
- 7.4 The Item Code designations in the specifications and on the plans are provided as an aid to successful bidders.

8. PREPARATION OF BIDS

8.1 Bids shall be submitted in duplicate on the Bid Proposal Form enclosed separately with the Bid Documents. Each Bidder shall indicate the extent of work upon which he wishes to propose by entering his bid prices in the appropriate spaces on the Bid Proposal. Make no marks adjacent to items upon which no bid is proposed. Excepting these specifically described spaces, the Bid Proposal Form shall be completely filled in and signed. Bids which are incomplete, conditional or obscure, or which contain additions not called for, will be rejected.

- 8.2 Bids shall be for the complete work of one or more number coded items in one or more CTE Large Equipment categories. Each Bidder must supply all pricing and identify all proposed items in the space provided for each item that he bids; it is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to completely identify the items upon which his bid is based.
- 8.3 Each Bidder shall retain one copy of bid documents for his records and file two (2) Bid Proposal Forms, complete with supporting literature with the City of Waltham at the place designated in the Notice to Suppliers. The bid shall be filed before the deadline designated in the Invitation to Bid. The bid must include the following documents:
 - i. Bid Proposal completed and signed with unit cost and total cost of each item bid. If an Alternate is bid, proposal must provide alternate's Manufacturer/Model Number along with supporting document as indicated in 8.3.x and 12. <u>SAMPLES</u>.
 - ii. Certificate of Non-Collusion completed and signed.
 - iii. Tax Compliance Certification completed and signed
 - iv. Certificate of Authority completed and signed
 - v. Statement of Corporate Authority completed and signed
 - vi. City of Waltham Bidder's Qualifications and References
 - vii. Public Contracts Department Certification completed and signed.
 - viii. W-9 completed and signed.
 - ix. Certificate of Insurance
 - x. Bid Deposit- as indicated in Paragraph 10, Invitation to Bid/Instructions to Bidders.
 - xi. Provide for each proposed <u>Alternate</u> manufacturer's catalog cuts. Include on each document the reference code number (i.e. CA109) for proposed Alternate, highlighting the exact manufacturer correlating model number, color/finish and or available colors/finishes. Also provide information that illustrates the conformity of the proposed alternate to the specification.
- 8.4 Each bid proposal shall be as instructed per Article 1.4.

The sealed envelope shall be enclosed in an outer-seal envelope and delivered to the address indicated in the INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS. If bids are forwarded by mail, they must be registered or certified. Any bid received after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids as established in the INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS shall be returned to the Bidder unopened.

9. MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

- 9.1 A bid may be modified or withdrawn by written notice received in the office designated in the Notice to Suppliers for submission of bids, provided that such request is received prior to the time and date established in the Notice to Suppliers for the bid opening. Modifications shall be sealed and marked in the same format applicable to bids. The City of Waltham will not be responsible, however, for the timely receipt of any request for modification or withdrawal, and Bidders are cautioned to transmit any such request for modification or withdrawal in ample time for delivery before the Bid Opening time.
- 9.2 No bidder may modify or withdraw his proposal after the actual opening thereof without the written permission of the City of Waltham, which shall be granted only pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 30B.

10. BID DEPOSIT

- 10.1 Each Bid Proposal shall be accompanied by a Bid Deposit in the form of cash, a certified check, a treasurer's check or cashier's check, or a bid bond issued by a responsible surety company licensed by the State Division of Insurance, payable to the City of Waltham in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid amount. Said Bid Deposit shall become and be the property of the City of Waltham as liquidated damages if, after an award is made to him, the Bidder shall fail to enter into the required contract and to execute the required Performance and Payment Bonds within five (5) working days after notice of said award is mailed or delivered to him.
- 10.2 Bidder's submitting cash, certified check or treasurer's check as a Bid Deposit shall, if successful, have their Bid Deposit retained by the City of Waltham until such time that the contractual obligations of the successful Bidder have been completed.
- 10.3 All Bid Deposits of successful bidders will be returned not later than ten (10) working days upon execution and delivery of the contract for the proposed work, or, if no award is made, not later than upon the expiration of ninety (90) working days following the opening of Bids.

11. PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BONDS

- 11.1 Each successful Bidder having submitted a Bid Bond shall furnish with the executed contract a Performance Bond and a Labor and Materials or Payment Bond. Performance and payment bonds shall each be in the sum of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price and shall be executed upon a form satisfactory to the City of Waltham. Each bond shall be of a surety company qualified to do business under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and satisfactory to the City of Waltham. The premiums are to be paid by the Contractor and shall be included in the Contract Price.
- 11.2 If the Contractor is a partnership, the bond shall be signed by each of the individuals who are partners; if a corporation, the bond shall be signed in the correct corporate name by a duly authorized officer. The executed bond shall be accompanied by a certified copy of the power-of-attorney where the bond is executed on behalf of the surety by an attorney-in-fact.

12. SAMPLES

- 12.1 Samples may be required from any bidder proposing an item other than the item specified in the Bid Documents. Each Bidder proposing such an alternate shall be prepared to submit samples of all alternate items on which his proposal has been based, within five (5) days, Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excluded, after receipt of bid from the Equipment Consultant. To facilitate comparison and evaluation of alternates, the Equipment Consultant may also request an example of the item named as a reference in the specification. Failure to provide samples as described herein within the time required will result in award to next lowest bidder.
- 12.2 Alternate items to those actually named or specified in the Bid Documents will be considered for approval as equals by the CTE Large Equipment Consultant only upon

receipt of the following by the CTEE Large Equipment Consultant at the location and within the time period designated by the Equipment Consultant:

i. One (1) truly representative sample of each item requested by the Equipment Consultant, complete in every respect, with regard to materials, gauges, thickness, finishes, and construction. No future compliance assertions to the Bid Documents, or "can do" provisions, made by the Bidder, will be accepted as consideration for approval as an equal, without specific written approval of the Equipment Consultant and City of Waltham.

Note: Technical Specifications and drawings indicating details of construction, catalog descriptions and brochures may not be accepted as sole compliance with this requirement.

- ii. Samples of the actual color and finishes as required under each Section integrally a part of or applied to the actual materials proposed for use under this Contract.
- iii. Manufacturer's printed methods and materials recommended for the cleaning and maintenance of each surface. A list of forbidden practices and typical cleaning agents which would cause manufacturer to request voiding of the guarantee.
- 12.3 All samples must be securely labeled with the name of the project and the following items:

Name, address and telephone number of the submitting bidder:

- 12.4 All charges in connection with the delivery and retrieval of samples shall be borne by the respective potential bidders.
- 12.5 The materials and/or equipment furnished under the Contact shall in all respects be equal in quality the samples submitted to and approved by the Equipment Consultant and/or City of Waltham.
- 12.6 If requested by vendor, samples will be returned if costs to return are prepaid by vendor.

13. SALES TAX EXEMPTION

13.1 All material and equipment, which will be incorporated into the project and which will become the property of the City of Waltham upon completion of said project, will be exempt from the Massachusetts Sales Tax. The Contractor shall obtain from the City of Waltham, the Sales Tax Exemption Number applicable for the project and shall include said number when ordering materials for the project.

14. AWARD OF CONTRACT AND QUANTITIES

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive minor informalities, and award contracts in the best interest of the Owner. The Owner's decision shall be final.

Award of "Extended Price" subcategories:

The award of the lowest price bid from the Responsive and Responsible bidder for each item will be determined by multiplying the "unit price" by the quantity listed for each item to determine the "extended price". The total bid value shall be a sum of the "extended price", the bid total per subcategory. Unit prices shall include delivery, installation and removal of debris. Labor shall comply with the Prevailing Wage. Wage applies only if the installation company will permanently secure equipment and/or fixtures to the building and/or grounds. If the installation company is permanently securing equipment and/or fixtures to the building and/or grounds the labor shall comply with the Carpenter's Prevailing Wage. Bidders do not need to bid every subcategory, but individual subcategories are to be bid in full where the "extended price" award formula is utilized. The subcategories that will be awarded on the basis of "extended price" include the following subcategories:

- 14.1 As used herein, the term "lowest responsible and responsive bidder" shall mean the Bidder whose Bid is the lowest of those Bidders possessing the capability to perform fully the contract requirements, and the integrity and reliability which assures good faith performance, and who has submitted a bid which conforms in all respects to the invitation for bids and instructions to bidders. The City of Waltham may require information in regard to such qualifications in such form, as it shall deem necessary.
- 14.2 Subject to Chapter 30B of the Massachusetts General Laws, the Owner reserves the right to vary the quantities of the items specified herein as may be necessary to meet the budget allowances of the project. In such instances, the "unit price" proposed on the Bid Forms submitted shall be extended to determine the contract price for the quantity purchased. Unit prices shall include delivery and installation.
- 14.3 The City of Waltham may award contracts based on either individual items or based on various items included in a section if it is in the public interest to do so.
- 14.4 An Award Recommendation, indicating all awarded items, quantities and cost will be issued to each successful bidder. If any bidder selected as the supplier for any item(s) or section(s) fails to sign and return this Award Recommendation within five (5) working

days after being furnished by the City of Waltham, an award may be made to the next lowest responsible and responsive bidder, and the bidder failing to perform shall forfeit his bid deposit.

14.5 Bids submitted and opened must remain fixed and in force, as submitted, for ninety (90) days (Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excluded) following the opening of bids, or until such later time as may be required by law.

15. REJECTION OF BIDS

15.1 The City of Waltham reserves the right to reject any or all bids if it deems it in its sole discretion to be in the public interest to do so, and to waive minor informalities or allow bidder to correct them, all in accordance with the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 30B.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. LOCATION

1.1. The work is to be performed at the Waltham High School, 554 Lexington Street, Waltham, MA.

2. <u>LEED v4 REQUIREMENTS</u>

2.1. The furniture must be tested for Low Emitting Materials in accordance with ANSI/BIFMA Standard Method M7.1-2011. Comply with ANSI/BIFMA e3-2011 Furniture Sustainability Standard, Sections 7.6.1 and 7.6.2, using either the concentration modeling approach or the emission factor approach. Furniture provided for open plan, private office and seating shall comply with such scenario in ANSI/BIFMA M7.1, as appropriate. All classroom furniture shall comply with standard school classroom model in CDPH Standard Method V1.1. The contractor shall submit product certification using USGBC approved equivalent testing methodologies.

3. SCHEDULE FOR PERFORMANCE OF THE WORK

- 3.1. The items to be provided under the contract shall be delivered and installed, as stated in paragraph 3. <u>DEFINITION OF INSTALLATION OWNERSHIP</u>. Please note that individual items may require more than one delivery to the same location.
- 3.2. At the request of the Equipment Consultant and no later than 30 days before the commencement of the installation period, the Contractor shall submit his detailed schedule for delivery and installation of the work.
- 3.3. The Contractor shall submit all samples, furnishings, shop drawings, and mock-ups to the Equipment Consultant as required by his particular items and the Contract Documents. He shall submit a copy of manufacturers' acknowledgments for each item. All submissions shall be complete within two calendar months after receipt of Contract.

4. DEFINITION OF INSTALLATION, OWNERSHIP

- 4.1. Installation shall have occurred when the Contractor has performed the following to the satisfaction of the Owner and as approved by the Equipment Consultant. Final installation is to be reviewed by the manufacturer's representative and/or sales representative with written documentation to be submitted to the Owner stating compliance with the following:
 - 4.1.1. Each and every item comprising the work has been furnished complete and as described in the Contract Documents.
 - 4.1.2. The material is located, attached, connected and/or otherwise in-place as shown on the Drawings or indicated in the Specifications.

- 4.1.3. The material is clean and polished, and the area is free from packing as required by the General Conditions.
- 4.1.4. Guarantees, maintenance manuals, keys and other loose items have been delivered to the Owner.
- 4.1.5. Any required instruction to the Owner has been satisfactorily given.
- 4.2. The Contractor shall receive all materials at the site. The Contractor shall be responsible for determining whether the quantities claimed have been delivered, and whether there is no apparent damage. The Owner reserves the right to refuse delivery of any shipment if it arrives in the absence of the Contractor or arrives on a date(s) not previously scheduled with the Owner or Equipment Consultant. Such shipments shall include, but will not be limited to, third party trucking companies, and shipments direct from the manufacturer.
- 4.3. The Contractor shall submit to the Equipment Consultant all packing slips/delivery receipts listing all items and quantities received for the project. <u>Invoices for the delivered and installed items will not be processed without this proof of delivery.</u>
- 4.4. The Contractor's installation of the materials must take place within the times approved by the Owner and the Equipment Consultant and in accordance with Section 5 below.
- 4.5. If the Contractor obtains early delivery of materials (prior to the scheduled installation period) he shall be entirely responsible for the receiving, handling, storage and final delivery of the materials, including warehousing as may be necessary until the start of the installation period. He shall make his own arrangement with all parties concerned in this regard.
- 4.6. If the Owner cannot make the premises available for final installation as shown on the drawings at the time scheduled for the installation period, he shall give timely notice to the Contractor. The Contractor, at his option, may choose to make his own temporary storage arrangements or may use a space provided at the project if available for the temporary storage of his material. In such cases the Owner will endeavor to protect material; however, the Owner shall not be liable for damages incurred during this period. The Owner will make appropriate partial payment up to but not exceeding 75% of the contract value of the delivered item, during this period for material if stored on his premises and will give timely notice of the readiness of the premises for final installation. By such storage and/or partial payment the Owner shall not be deemed to have accepted nor shall the Contractor be deemed to have installed the material.
- 4.7. The Owner's acceptance shall take place upon final installation and completion of the work to the Owner's satisfaction in accordance with the Contract Documents. For insurance and other purposes, however, the Owner's interest shall be in direct relation to the amount of partial payment made upon the account.
- 4.8. If any work which has been previously accepted, specifically or by the making of payment, is found to have defects, damage, or deficiencies, of fails to conform to the Contract Documents, the Owner may revoke acceptance. Such revocation shall be made by giving prompt notice to the Contractor, and the Contractor shall promptly remedy the same at his own expense.

4.9. If the Contractor is required to perform work to remedy defects, damage or deficiencies after May 24, 2024, CORI Forms and background checks will be required prior to the Contractor coming onto the site/premises.

5. OWNER'S REMEDY FOR DELAY

- 5.1. It is understood and agreed that time is of the essence of this Contract. If the Contractor fails to achieve final completion of any portion of the work by the applicable Contract Completion Date, the Owner shall, without prejudice to any other remedy the Owner may have, require that the Contractor supply similar items deemed suitable by the Owner on a temporary basis for the intended use. These items must be placed in accordance with the Contract Documents and removed by the Contractor at the time of installation of the actual items purchased. Such temporary furnishings or equipment must be installed in conformance with the scheduled completion dates set forth in the contract at no cost to the owner.

For CM AT RISK projects (bid pursuant to G.L. c.149A), the earlier of: (a) the execution date of the GMP Amendment, or (b) the bid for the first construction scope of work must be within 90-days of the wage schedule issuance date.
- The wage schedule shall be incorporated in any advertisement or call for bids for the project as required by M.G.L. c. 149, § 27. The wage schedule shall be made a part of the contract awarded for the project. The wage schedule must be posted in a conspicuous place at the work site for the life of the project in accordance with M.G.L. c. 149 § 27. The wages listed on the wage schedule must be paid to employees performing construction work on the project whether they are employed by the prime contractor, a filed sub-bidder, or a sub-
- Apprentices working on the project are required to be registered with the Massachusetts Division of Apprentice Standards (DAS). Apprentices must keep their apprentice identification card on their persons during all work hours on the project. An apprentice registered with DAS may be paid the lower apprentice wage rate at the applicable step as provided on the prevailing wage schedule. Any apprentice not registered with DAS regardless of whether they are registered with another federal, state, local, or private agency must be paid the iournevworker's rate.
- · Every contractor or subcontractor working on the construction project must submit weekly payroll reports and a Statement of Compliance directly to the awarding authority by mail or email and keep them on file for three years. Each weekly payroll report must contain: the employee's name, address, occupational classification, hours worked, and wages paid. Do not submit weekly payroll reports to DLS. - · Contractors with questions about the wage rates or classifications included on the wage schedule have an affirmative obligation to inquire with DLS at (617) 626-6953.
- · Contractors must obtain the wage schedules from awarding authorities.
