Waltham Recycling and Trash Guidelines:

- Recycling and trash is collected weekly in Waltham. Containers must be placed curbside one hour before sundown the night before your scheduled pick-up day, or by 7:00am on your scheduled pick-up day.
- REPORT A MISSED RECYCLING / TRASH / YARD WASTE PICK-UP to 781-314-3855, Monday - Friday, 7am-3pm.
- Trash barrels cannot exceed 32 gallons or 50 lbs .
- All trash must be put out for collection in a barrel with a lid. Only 2 bulk items per week.
- Please keep at least 5 feet in between your recycling cart and trash containers, or place on alternate sides of driveway so trash barrels don't get knocked over by toter tipper. Label them accordingly.
- Place trash and recycling carts in front of snowbanks when possible.


## E-Waste and Appliances

EZ Disposal \& Recycling will pick up TV \& computer monitors, and major appliances such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, washers, dryers, \& metal cabinets by appointment only. Call them at 781-233-2211 at least 24 hours in advance before putting these items out on your regularly scheduled trash \& recycling pick-up day. Special pick-ups require advance scheduling of separate truck. Items must be placed curbside by 7 am . Driver does not assist with transport to curb. You can report abandoned items to EZ Disposal at 781-233-2211.

NO PLASTIC BAGS! DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES


PLEASE DO NOT PUT RECYCLABLES IN PLASTIC BAGS \& DO NOT PUT ANY PLASTIC BAGS IN THE RECYCLING CART. The bags get caught and jam the sorting machinery. Put all items directly in the cart (no separation necessary).

Plastic bags can be dropped off at local supermarkets: Market Basket, Hannafords, Shaws.

## HAZARDOUS PRODUCTS RECYCLING \& DISPOSAL

Residents may take their hazardous products to the Minuteman Hazardous Products Facility in Lexington, MA, one weekend day per month, April through November, 9am-2pm. Bring proof of Waltham residency - license or Waltham bill. Please take all your hazardous products at one time and limit your visits to once per season. Only have one item? Try collecting with your neighbors!

## Directions to Minuteman Facility - 60 Hartwell Ave, Lexington, MA:

Take Route 128 North. Take Exit 31 B, Bedford (Route 4/North/Route 225 West) off Route 128. At the end of the exit ramp, remain in the right lane. Bear right to enter the jug-handle to turn left \& continue straight through the traffic light onto Hartwell Avenue. Travel 0.5 miles south on Hartwell Avenue and take the first left after the pedestrian traffic signal at the bikeway.

There will be no collection on days circled with a slash symbol $\theta$. Instead, pick-up will be completed one day after your regularly scheduled pick-up day, on days with an underline.

Preparing your Yard Waste for Pick-up: Include leaves, grass and all other easily raked material. Small twigs \& branches less than 2 inches in diameter and less than 3 feet long are okay. No stumps, logs, rocks or stones. Must be in paper leaf bags or barrels up to 50lbs marked with "Yard Waste". Free stickers are available at 165 Lexington St.

Yard Waste Pick-up: EZ Disposal \& Recycling collects YW every other week. Collection alternates according to your address. To find out what your yard Waste Week is (A-Week or B-Week), go to: city.waltham.ma.us/recycling-department/yard-waste-schedule
