Waltham Recycling and Trash Guidelines

- · Recycling and trash is collected weekly in Waltham. Containers must be placed curbside one hour before sundown the night before your scheduled pick-up day, or by 7:00am on your scheduled pick-up day.
- The city provides each household with a blue Recycling Cart. Trash Barrels are the responsibility of the property owner to provide. To get a new or additional recycling cart, please call 781-314-3390.
- All trash must be put out for collection in a barrel with a lid. Only 2 bulk items per week. Trash barrels cannot exceed 32 gallons or 50lbs.
- Please keep at least 5 feet in between your recycling cart and trash containers, or place on alternate sides of driveway so trash barrels don't get knocked over. Label them accordingly. Place trash and recycling carts in front of snowbanks when possible.
- When there is a holiday, trash and recycling pick-up will be delayed 1 day. There will be no collection on the observed holiday. If a holiday falls on a Sunday, the holiday will be observed on Monday. If the holiday falls on a Saturday, the holiday will be observed on Friday. See the calendar in this brochure for holiday schedule.
- You can report a missed recycling, trash, & yard waste pick-up to 781-314-3855, Monday - Friday, 7am-3pm.
- To report improper disposal of trash & recycling, please call 781-314-3855.

- Please do not recycle anything that is NOT pictured on the lid of the recycling carts. All plastic bags and styrofoam should be put into your trash barrels.
- Yard Waste is collected every other week from April -December. The city also provides a Leaf Vacuum Program to collect leaves one day per year from November -December. See the attached calendar for more.

CONSTRUCTION WASTE DISPOSAL

In an effort to reduce the disposal of construction and demolition materials in household waste, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection has implemented waste disposal bans on many of the materials generated during construction and demolition. Please do not include any type of contruction waste in your trash barrels or recycling carts. The trash hauler will NOT collect it. Banned materials include the following:

- Asphalt Pavement
- Brick
- Concrete
- Metal
- Wood
- Clean Gypsum Wallboard (drywall)
- Toilets

Contractors are generally responsible for disposal of construction and demolition debris. Residents are instructed to contract a private hauler for construction waste disposal. For more info on the MA waste bans, visit: mass.gov/guides/massdep-waste-disposal-bans

Call them at 781-233-2211 at least 24 hours in advance before putting these items out on your regularly scheduled trash & recycling pick-up day. Special pick-ups require advance scheduling of separate truck. Items must be placed curbside by 7am. Driver does not assist with transport to curb. You can report abandoned items to EZ Disposal at 781-233-2211.

NEW Waste Bans effective in MA as of November 1, 2022


MassDEP issued a Master Plan which established goals to reduce overall waste & disposal statewide by 30% (from 5.7 million tons in 2018 to 4 million tons in 2030) over the next decade, with a long term goal of achieving a 90% reduction in disposal to 570,000 tons by 2050. Among its strategies for reaching these objectives, MassDEP has expanded its current waste disposal bans by adding mattresses and textiles to the list of materials banned from disposal of transport for disposal in MA. No Collection (holiday): When there is a holiday, trash and recycling pick up may be DELAYED ONE DAY for the rest of the week. There will be no collection on days circled with a slash symbol S. Instead, pick-up will be completed one day after your regularly scheduled pick-up day, on days with an underline.

Preparing your Yard Waste for Pick-up: Include leaves, grass and all other easily raked material. Small twigs & branches less than 2 inches in diameter and less than 3 feet long are okay. No stumps, logs, rocks or stones. Must be in paper leaf bags or barrels up to 50lbs marked with "Yard Waste". Free stickers are available at 165 Lexington St.

Yard Waste Pick-up: EZ Disposal & Recycling collects YW every other week. Collection alternates according to your address. To find out what your yard Waste Week is (A-Week or B-Week), go to: city.waltham.ma.us/recycling-department/yard-waste-schedule

Blue-shaded weeks indicate YW pick-up for A-WEEK residents.
Collection BEGINS April 4th, 2022 and ENDS on Dec. 2nd, 2022

Un-shaded weeks indicate YW pick-up for B-WEEK residents. Collection BEGINS April 11th, 2022 and ENDS Dec. 9th, 2022

Leaf Vacuum Program Collection Dates: Leaves from each household will be vacuumed 1 DAY/YEAR, Mon-Fri, according to the following schedule.

NEW FOR 2022 - Reduction of Plastic Bags!

In an effort to reduce environmental pollution & conserve resources, implementation of a new City of Waltham Ordinance regarding the reduction of plastic bags will be **taking effect on June 25th**, **2022!** The ordinance prohibits retailers from providing single-use plastic checkout bags to any customer for the purpose of enabling them to carry goods from the point of sale. If a retailer does provide checkout bags to customers, such bags must be either a recyclable paper bag, or a reusable bag. Your existing stock of single-use plastic bags should be phased out by June 24th 2022. Any stock of single-use plastic bags remaining as of June 25th 2022 must be properly disposed of at that time (in the trash).

ONLY THESE ITEMS BELONG IN YOUR RECYCLING CART

All recyclables (paper, plastic, glass, cans) may go together in your recycling cart. No separation necessary! Please do not recycle anything not pictured on the lid. All recycling MUST be placed in your recycling cart with the lid fully closed. Need to get a new or additional recycling cart? Call 781-314-3390.
