Veterans Services Director Michael Russo and City Assessor Bernadette Vasquez appeared before the committee.

Mr. Russo stated that the City has previously accepted other Veteran exemptions. The City is looking to accept these two additional clauses;

- 1. Chapter 59-5-22G Allows owner of the property to continue to get the exemption even if the property is put into a trust. As long as the Veteran continues to live at the property.
- 2. Chapter 59-5-22H If the Veteran is killed in action this exemption allows the parents of the Veteran to receive this exemption as long as the parents are living in this property.

Councillor McLaughlin asked how does the City know if someone is a Veteran. Mr. Russo said some information flows from Veteran agencies but many times they get informed by the Veteran notifying them.

Councillor McLaughlin moved approval on adopting the BRAVE ACT. Motion was adopted on a voice vote

Councillor McLaughlin moved to adjourn. Motion was adopted on a voice vote and the meeting was adjourned at 5:55 p.m.
