Dear Property Owners,

SECTION 115 STOP WORK ORDER

stop work order. either contrary to the provisions of 780 CMR or dangerous or unsafe, the building official is authorized to issue a 15.1 Authority. Whenever the building official finds any work regulated by 780 CMR being performed in a manner

work order shall state the reason for the order, and the conditions under which the cited work-will be permitted to the person doing the work. Upon issuance of a stop work order, the cited work shall immediately cease. The stop time and date of the verbal order and be given to the owner of the property involved, or to the owner's agent, or to 115.2 Issuance. The initial stop work order may be verbal, but shall be in writing within 48 hours and shall cite the

subject to penalties as prescribed by M.G.L. c. 143, § 94(a). Each day during which a violation exists shall order, except such work as that person is directed to perform to remove a violation or unsafe condition, shall be constitute a separate offense. 115.3 Unlawful Continuance. Any person who shall continue any work after having been served with a stop work
